Dear Resident:

The City invites you to a neighborhood meeting on Thursday, December 19th at 6:00 pm at the Municipal Center located at 7100 147th St W to discuss stormwater improvements at Redwood Pond (Park).

Public Works staff is currently evaluating the feasibility of expanding Redwood Pond, located north of the intersection of Redwood Drive and 150th St West. This project may include modifications in and around Redwood Pond, realignment of the existing trail, and new landscaping all while trying to maintain the existing character of the park.

The expansion of Redwood Pond was one of several water quality improvement projects recommended in the Keller Lake Sub-watershed Assessment Report completed in 2017 and is identified in the City's Capital Improvement Program. Because the project will improve water quality draining to Keller Lake, the City leveraged grant funding from the state's Clean Water Fund to help fund the project.
