

## **Pavement Preservation Work (Micro Surfacing)**

Micro surfacing has been scheduled for the neighborhoods shown on map below beginning Monday, July 31 with completion Friday, August 11, 2017 (weather dependent). The work will start in the area designated as Phase 1 on the map and finish in Phase 3. Residents should watch for temporary No Parking signs, which will be placed the day before work begins along the streets scheduled for micro surfacing.

Micro surfacing is not a street overlay and will not look like “New” asphalt when completed, it is a pavement preservation technique used to extend the life of the existing pavement. The work involves placement of a thin oil/aggregate slurry material over the full width of the existing asphalt pavement. A curing time of approximately 1 hour is required before residents can back out of their driveway across the new surface. One traffic lane will remain open on main roads in the subdivisions. Dead end roads and side roads may experience road closures.

Depending on weather, the newly surfaced road will be ready for full vehicle traffic approximately 2 hours after application.
